**BELSS:**

S. Simmons motioned and N. Eubanks 2<sup>nd</sup> Resolution R-01-26 Authorizing Mayor Reisinger to enter into contract with Choice One Engineering for the Southeast Side storm sewer project.. Passed 4-0
