

How to Use Programs Offered at Farmers Markets?



Visit the farmers market information booth before you shop. Ask about food programs and recipes. Market staff are there to help you.



Swipe your SNAP/EBT card and you can get an extra \$1 for every dollar you spend through the Produce Perks program. (Up to \$25 match per day.)



Shop using your SNAP dollars to buy any SNAP-eligible foods at the market. Produce Perks tokens can be used for bonus fruits and vegetables.

WIC vouchers are distributed by your local WIC office and are given directly to participating farmers. Senior Farmers Market vouchers are distributed by senior services and are given directly to participating farmers.
